

## CURRICULUM VITAE

### Miladin Ševarlić



Prof. Miladin Ševarić, Ph.D. is a special advisor at the Economics Institute.

He was born in 1949 in Čačak. He is an agricultural economist and a full professor of narrow area of expertise - Agricultural economics (courses: Agricultural economics, Cooperatives and associations in agro-economy, World agriculture and food safety, Advisory services in agriculture and rural development, Economics of rural tourism, Agricultural and Rural Policy). Mr. Ševarlić is also Head of the Department of Agriculture and Markets Economics at the Institute of Agro-economy, Agricultural Faculty, University of Belgrade. In September 2012 he was promoted to Honorary Professor at the Volgograd State Agricultural

University (VolGAU).

Independently and in collaboration with other authors, he has published more than 280 bibliographic units in the country and abroad, including three editions of the textbook on Agricultural economics, the two national agricultural development strategies (1982, 1999), four macro-economic solutions recognized at the national level, chapters in 20 monographs, more than 130 scientific and 40 professional papers, 35 studies and programmes. Professor Ševarlić's journalistic oeuvre comprises over 350 editorials, interviews, opinions, debates, statements and other forms of performance in the national and foreign media, on the issues covering the field of agro-economy. He has held over 100 lectures at seminars and conferences in the country and, as an invited speaker, five lectures abroad. He works as a consultant at a number of companies and associations in the field of agro-economy.

He was a mentor and a member of the evaluation committees for application and defense of more than 70 graduation theses, 24 master's theses and 12 doctoral dissertations, as well as President or a member of more than 30 committees for election to educational and scientific degrees in the country and abroad. He is a member of the Editorial Board of the leading national Agricultural Economics Journal, an editor of 12 monographs and thematic collections of national and international conferences, a consulting editor of 20 monographs and other scientific papers, President or a member of programme and organizing committees of over 20 international and national scientific meetings.

He was also a part-time lecturer at other universities in Serbia (1988-1993 and 2004-2010: Faculty of Agronomy, Čačak, and 2002-2006: Military Academy in Belgrade), Bosnia and Herzegovina (1988-1991: Agricultural Faculty in Sarajevo and the Mostar Department) and in Croatia (1989-1991: Agricultural Faculty in Osijek and the Vinkovci Department).

He attended specializations, was on study trips, seminars and official visits in: Slovenia, Poland, Hungary, USSR, Israel, USA, Czech Republic, Russian Federation, Ukraine, Bulgaria, Romania, Belgium, Holland, Italy, Greece ... He was a manager of one team and a member of another on two international projects, and also a manager of two teams and a member of a team on nine national projects.

He is President of the Serbian Association of Agricultural Economists, President of the Association of Agricultural Engineers and Technicians of Serbia and President of the Cooperative Movement. He is a member of the Scientific Society of Serbian Economists and of EAAE – European Association of Agricultural Economist. He is also a member of Editorial Council of the professional journal *ИЗВЕСТИЈА* – ISBN 2071-9485, VolGAU, Volgograd (the Russian Federation).
