Svetlana Kisić is a special advisor at the Economics Institute.

For more than 25 years she has been lecturing Economics of Enterprise and Enterprise Organization at the Belgrade Business School - High School of Vocational Studies, where she has worked from the beginning of her professional involvement to date. During her career at the Belgrade Business School she held the position of Head of the Department of Finance and Accounting (1994 to 1998), Head of the Department of Economics (2000 – 2003 and 2008 – to date) and a member of the Managing Board in several terms of office. During the academic year 1992/93 she was a lecturer in Entrepreneurship at the Faculty of Management, University of "Braca Karić".

She began her career in consulting in 1987 at the Economics Institute Belgrade, and from 1994 to July 2007 worked as Director of the Financial Consulting Department at the renowned audit and consulting company Deloitte. During her career at Deloitte she passed the system of courses for both the development of professional knowledge related to financial consulting and for the development of managerial skills. Since July 2007 she has been a special advisor at the Economics Institute Belgrade.

Throughout her career as a consultant she has worked on over 80 projects. She managed independently more than 50 projects for the clients who represent the biggest Serbian enterprises in relevant fields. She has specialized in issues on privatization, enterprise restructuring, defining of strategy development, financial consolidation of companies, organizational restructuring. Some of the said projects are: "Defining the strategy for restructuring and privatization of the Serbian defense industry"; Consulting in the process of merging "Apatinska pivara" (the Apatin Brewery) with the Interbrew CE Holding BV; Consulting for the "Galaxy" USA company in the tender privatization of RUMAGUMA; Consulting for the Agrokor Holding in the tender privatization of "Frikom" a.d., etc...

Due to her professional engagement she was elected Chairman of the Managing Board of the Viskoza Holding Loznica (since 2003), President of the Supervisory Board of the Economics Institute Belgrade (since 2006) and a member of the Managing Board of UniCredit Bank Serbia (since 2011).

She is a member of the Presidency of the Serbian Association of Economists. She currently chairs the Women's Government, an organization dealing with the promotion of expert potential of women in Serbia. She is also engaged in the international association Junior Achievement, as President of the Managing Board of the Serbian branch, the association aiming at the development of basic economic knowledge among the young.

She has published, independently or as a co-author, a large number of books, studies, articles and textbooks. She has also participated in numerous professional conferences and symposia.
