Ivan Nikolić



Ivan Nikolić is a senior associate at the Economics Institute and a co-author of the monthly journal, "Macroeconomic Analyses and Trends - MAT". His field of expertise includes macroeconomic trends in Serbia and in the surroundings.

He was born on June 13, 1975 in Belgrade. He graduated in 2001 from the Belgrade Faculty of Economics and received his M.Sc. in 2007. He currently undergoes doctoral studies at the same Faculty, on the efficiency of privatization in Serbia.

In his career Ivan Nikolić has been involved in the development of numerous national and international studies and projects and has authored a number of scientific papers. The results of his research, among other things, were published in national magazines in the relevant fields. His most notable projects are: Post-crisis model of economic growth and development of Serbia 2011-2020 (USAID, 2010); Development Strategy of the Republic of Serbia (EI Banja Luka, 2010); Development of early warning system on the possibility of an emerging currency and financial crisis in Serbia (NBS, 2008); Possible ways of restructuring the Serbian industry - experiences of newly acceded EU members and guiding principles for the WTO market access negotiations (UNCTAD, 2007); National Economic Development Strategy 2006-2012 (Economics Institute, 2006); Serbian National Strategy for the Accession of SCG to the EU (Economics Institute, 2005); Analytical and informative basis for EFTA negotiations with Serbia and Montenegro (Ministry of International Economic Relations, 2004), Competitiveness of Serbian Economy (Jefferson Institute and NBS, 2003).

In 2012 he was appointed a member of the Council of the Governor of the National Bank of Serbia.
